



Medications Newly Approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration

Recently, the below medications have been approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and require prior authorization immediately. Health Net Community Solutions, Inc. (Health Net) has listed the medications below under Outpatient Pharmaceuticals (Submitted under Medical Benefit) on the prior authorization requirements list.

Medication	FDA Approval Date and Indication
Luxturna™	Approved on December 19, 2017, for the treatment of patients with confirmed biallelic RPE65 mutation-associated retinal dystrophy
Prevymis™	Approved on November 9, 2017, for prophylaxis of cytomegalovirus (CMV) infection and disease in adult CMV-seropositive recipients [R+] of an allogeneic hematopoietic stem cell transplant (HSCT)
Yescarta™	Approved on October 18, 2017, for relapsed or refractory large-B-cell lymphoma after 2 or more lines of systemic therapy
