Recognizing Signs of Suicide Risk

Upcoming training sessions offered by the American Association of Suicidology

Health Net Community Solutions, Inc. (Health Net) and CalViva Health are sharing information with primary care physicians (PCPs), physician assistants (PAs) and registered nurses (RNs) about an upcoming learning collaborative on recognizing and responding to suicide risk (RRSR). OVERVIEW

The Fresno Suicide Prevention Collaborative is sponsoring the training on RRSR. The American Association of Suicidology is presenting the training, which will be led by Matthew B. Wintersteen, PhD, an associate professor and Director of Research in the Division of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at Sidney Kimmel Medical College at Thomas Jefferson University.

COURSE DESCRIPTION, SCHEDULE AND REGISTRATION

RRSR is a series of trainings that focuses on eight topical areas, which expand to cover 24 core competencies. The evidence-based treatment guidelines that will be used in the training were developed by a panel of renowned experts in the field of suicidology.
