

Correction to Measles Outbreak Cases

Measles cases continue to climb

Provider update 19-395, *Measles Outbreak Plagues California*, sent on May 17, 2019, incorrectly noted measles cases in California. As of May 7, 2019, measles cases reached 764 **nationwide**. No other changes have been made to provider update 19-395.

Nationwide cases reach 880 in 24 states

As of May 17, 2019, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reported measles cases keep climbing in the United States, reaching 880 cases in 24 states this year. For the latest information on the measles outbreak go to:
