



Earn \$2,500 For Closing CIS-10 Immunization Care Gaps (MY 2026 Age Extension)

**2026 CIS-10 PROVIDER INCENTIVE PROGRAM
EXTENDED THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027**

Health Net* offers providers a \$2,500 incentive for each eligible Ambetter HMO and PPO (Marketplace) member when the provider closes the Childhood Immunization Status – Combination 10 (CIS-10) care gap before the child turns 2.5 years (30 months). The CIS-10 care gap is closed by administering and/or documenting all required immunizations. The Rotavirus vaccine is excluded, as it is not clinically appropriate to administer after 8 months of age.

This incentive applies to current and newly assigned members under your care. The table below outlines the 10 recommended vaccines that must be completed or appropriately documented to meet CIS-10 requirements.

Providers may earn \$2,500 per eligible member when the CIS-10 care gap is closed through:

- Administration and documentation of all required CIS-10 vaccines by age 2.5 years, or
- Submission of valid documentation supporting a measure exclusion (e.g., contraindication), once verified.



Support childhood immunization. Close care gaps. Earn \$2,500 per eligible member.



What you need to do:

1

Identify open CIS-10 care gaps

- Review Health Net’s care gap reports to identify members who have not yet met CIS-10 requirements. For assistance, contact your Health Net representative.

2

Complete and document required immunizations

- Contact parents or guardians of children to schedule and complete any outstanding immunizations before the child turns 2.5 years.

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How to receive incentives:

After closing the CIS-10 care gap:

- Upload vaccines administered that complete CIS-10 requirements to the California Immunization Registry (CAIR2) at bit.ly/CAIRSignIn.

Note: Physicians and practitioners may also submit documentation for children excluded from the measure (e.g., due to a contraindication). Once verified, the physician or practitioner can still qualify for the incentive.

CIS-10: Child and adolescent immunization series

The following are required to close the CIS-10 care gap. All doses must be administered (or documented) by the child's 2.5 birthday, unless otherwise noted.

Vaccines	Doses (count)	Due date
Diphtheria, tetanus, and acellular pertussis (DTaP)	4	On or before 2.5 birthdate
Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib)	3	On or before 2.5 birthdate
Hepatitis A (HepA)	1	After 1st birthday up to 2.5 birthdate
Hepatitis B (HepB)	3	On or before 2.5 birthdate
Inactivated poliovirus (IPV)	3	On or before 2.5 birthdate
Influenza (Flu)	2	Starting at 6 months to 2.5 birthdate
Measles, mumps and rubella (MMR)	1	After 1st birthday up to 2.5 birthdate
Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV)	4	On or before 2.5 birthdate
Rotavirus (RV)	2 or 3	2 doses at 2 and 4 months (Rotarix) 3 doses at 2, 4 and 6 months (RotaTeq®) Note: Cannot be administered beyond 8 months, 0 days
Varicella (VZV)	1	After 1st birthday up to 2.5 birthdate
