Hazel Health provides on-demand telehealth care in schools and supports the school nurse when a child has an urgent need for care.



Better access to care

Hazel helps patients access more care, without losing time from school. Hazel can help kids find a medical home, too. Along with better short-term access, Hazel can foster the long-term relationship with local providers.



Referrals and follow-up

If a primary care physician's information is provided on the new patient questionnaire, Hazel will send follow-up records to the child's provider.

For kids needing behavioral health services, Hazel Heath can email or fax a referral form to MHN, Health Net's* behavioral health administrator. MHN will refer members who require care management to the appropriate Health Net care management team for follow up, as needed.



Hazel helps close care gaps

When Hazel closes care gaps for your Health Net Medi-Cal patients, you can receive an incentive payment as though you closed the gap yourself.

Gap closures apply for any of the Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) measures in the HEDIS Improvement Program (HIP) incentive that apply to children.
