

Extended-Days Supply Prescription

Extended-Days prescriptions (90 to 100-day supply) give patients a simple way to adhere to taking their medications.

They also offer added convenience.

Standard 30-day fills of maintenance medications require patients to make a trip to the pharmacy every single month, year after year. However, when you write for an extended-day prescription, patients' pharmacy trips drop from 12 annual trips to only three or four.



Members can fill their Extended-Days prescriptions at any willing network pharmacy, but our members may benefit financially if they use **Medication Home-Delivery through Express Scripts®**. The table below represents the Medicare Advantage formulary benefit for using Medication Home-Delivery through Express Scripts®, which includes \$0 copays for Tier 1 and 2 medications and up to \$20 savings every month for select medications in Tier 1 through Tier 3, and Tier 6 with an Extended-Days supply.
