

# Extended-Day Supply Prescription



**Extended-Day prescriptions (100-day supply) give patients a simple way to adhere to taking their medications.**

**They also offer added convenience.**

*Standard 30-day fills of maintenance medications require patients to make a trip to the pharmacy every single month. However, when you write for an extended-day prescription, patients' pharmacy trips drop from 12 trips per year to only four.*



Members can fill their Extended-Day prescriptions at any network pharmacy offering extended day supplies. Our members may benefit financially during the initial coverage stage if they use a preferred pharmacy such as **Home Delivery through Express Scripts®**. The table below represents the Medicare Advantage formulary benefit for using Medication Home-Delivery through Express Scripts, which includes \$0 co-pays for tier 1, 2 and 6 medications for ALL Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug (MAPD) plans, including Chronic Special Needs (C-SNP) and Dual Eligible Special Needs (D-SNP) plans.

<sup>1</sup>**Cost savings:** Standard (non-preferred) retail and mail order pharmacy extended day supply medication costs for C-SNP and regular MAPD plans are \$15 for tier 1 and \$30 for tier 2, respectively. These costs are reduced to \$0 when using extended day supply fills through Express Scripts Home Delivery.

<sup>2</sup>**Cost savings:** ALL plans will have \$0 co-pay for tier 6 medications for extended day supplies when using Express Scripts Home-Delivery.
