

What is Cozeva?

In early 2020, the Plan rolled out a web-based platform to help providers stay engaged in Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) performance and raise county benchmarks. The Cozeva® platform gives providers a bird's-eye view of members who need preventive care and chronic disease management services, as well as timely insights into member care transitions from emergent and inpatient settings. The system is user-friendly and provides an at-a-glance color coding system that shows providers which members are due for routine screenings or immunizations.



Start using Cozeva to identify any data gaps/discrepancies that exist with the Plan. Submit missing records as supplemental data where necessary to address those gaps by February 4, 2022.

Cozeva is available at no cost to CalViva Health primary care physicians and clinic providers, as well as to participating provider groups. There is no limit to the number of accounts that can be set up for a provider office.


